DOG OF THE YEAR



Requirements and conditions that apply exclusively to Dog of the Year events.

- · Events will run under UKC Elite Shed Dog Series format and rules.
- · 8 qualifying runs at DOY events are required to qualify for Dog of the Year.
- Top 4 placements will be awarded/recorded for each class on each day for Champion AND Working.
- Dog of the Year Series events can be held as 3-day events but ONLY Saturday and Sunday Runs will count towards D.O.Y points.
- Entries may not close until the cut-off date which can be no sooner than 1 month before the event.
- Dogs in heat must be allowed to run in Dog of the Year events.
- · Judges and Planters may run for passes towards titles but may not be in contention for DOY points at the event they are judging. If a judge/planters dog is in heat, it cannot run.
- · Running order shall be new and random for each day of the event.
- In the case of a points tie, the dog with the most 1st place wins will prevail, if tied for 1st place wins, the 2nd place will be reviewed and so on.
- · No course will be run twice by the same class for a Dog of the Year event days.
- · 3 dogs per class, per handler limit for DOY events.
- · Dog of the Year event judges must have had 6 previous assignments in the class they are judging.
- DOY events should make every effort to have the fewest number of plants possible before the first dog in the running order.
- · The judge or a non-competing event official will randomly and blindly determine the blanks.

Points Format

1st = 1x #of dogs entered in class 2nd = 0.75x #of dogs entered in class 3rd = 0.5x #of dogs entered in class 4th = 0.25x #of dogs entered in class Pass = 2 points

NEW FOR CHAMPION & WORKING CLASS

(Does not affect non-retriever class scoring) A dog will not receive credit for more passes than podium finishes.

Example: 4 podium finishes earn point opportunity for up to 4 passes.

The order in which they are earned does not matter.

Regardless of number of podium finishes, passes still count towards qualifying runs.
